Since we do not charge the Zambians for medical flights and all medical emergencies are paid for by the Hospital or the missionaries themselves, the Flight Service has established a **Medical Emergency/Compassionate Fund** to help cover half of the costs, that is reserved for such times.

NEWS FLASH

"During our recent engine inspection (Sept 25 & 26) on the plane for CMML Flight Service, we discovered a potential problem with the engine. It was decided for safety reasons, that we should not fly until the problem can be rectified. Since there are less than 80 hours remaining on the current engine before the required engine change, we decided to change it earlier than expected. We had hoped we could have received a 300 hour extension to the engine life through the Department of Civil Aviation as it was in good condition. This would have allowed us to do the engine change early next year. We had planned on sending the new engine by sea through the ACCTS containers in October. However, this now means that the new engine which we have ordered will need to be air freighted out from the USA as soon as possible. **Please pray** that it would arrive soon, and that all the additional costs would be kept to a minimum. **Pray** that our 'down time' would also be kept to a minimum, that we may continue transporting the Lord's servants. This has taken us by surprise but we see the Lord's hand in it, in that the engine was ordered and able to be made in time for shipment."
